Those interested in speaking or presenting a concurrent session or poster at the Australasia Pacific Play Therapy Association (APPTA) Annual Conference are invited to supply a 250 word synopsis of the topic and method of presentation, together with brief information about themselves and any co-presenters, to the Conference Secretariat by **10th March 2008**.
